

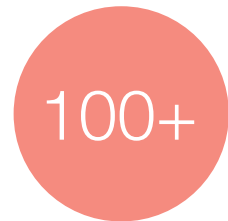


This is ISN

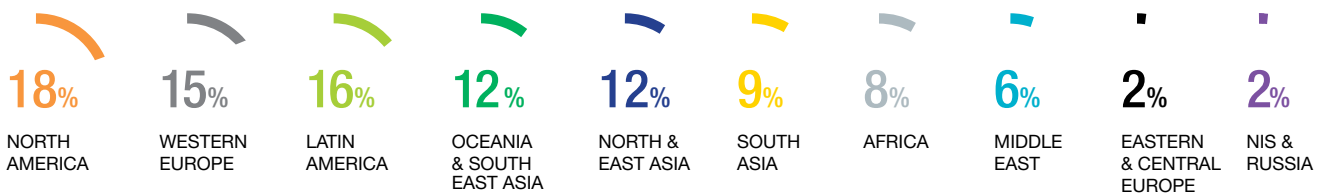
Top 10 countries (2017)
