




Global Burden of Acute Kidney Injury: Epidemiology, Mortality, and Disability-Adjusted



Annual incident AKI cases




Related deaths worldwide

*At the national level, Argentina, Japan, Malaysia, and Brazil exhibited the highest DALY rates, while India, Peru, and Pakistan were among the lowest.

#Highest in the Americas 942 per 100,000 population
Lowest in South-East Asia at 126 per 100,000 population.

Conclusion: AKI represents a substantial global health burden, with high mortality and DALYs, highlighting the urgent need for early detection, timely management, and structured post-AKI follow-up.
