### **Candidate's Statement**

#### **Short statement of objective on what I plan to accomplish as the ISN Western Europe Regional Board Deputy Chair/Councilor between 2021 and 2023**

It will be an honor and pleasure to serve as the ISN deputy chair for Western Europe between 2021 and 2023. I honestly believe to be a suitable candidate because I am deeply rooted in European Nephrology for more than two decades of joint clinical and research projects. Examples are the initiation of the first cross national border kidney paired exchange program, my many positions in European academic nephrology (ET, ESOT, EDTA) and consortial research projects funded by the EU (FP-6, FP-7, MCIOF, H2020, H2020-IMI). An example of my global educational activities is the recently published KDIGO global transplant guideline (Transplantation. 2020;104(4):708-714.).

If the council elects me as new member, I will specifically plan to increase the global awareness of ESRD and specifically transplantation. This will be necessary to allocate public funds to this entity and allow for education, training, and program setups of future generations of nephrologists to achieve the one goal: **How to best treat patients.**
