2023 ISN-GKHA AIM AND OBJECTIVES

The aim of this third iteration of the ISN–GKHA is to understand the current status of global and regional capacity for the delivery of care to people living with CKD and kidney failure.

Using the <u>Universal Health Coverage (UHC)</u> domains defined by the World Health Organization (WHO), this survey summarizes and compares the availability, accessibility, and affordability of high-quality care for people living with kidney disease across regions and countries worldwide.

The key focus of the ISN-GKHA is on capacity, availability, accessibility, affordability, and outcomes of kidney disease.
