## About the program

The ISN Train the Trainer (TTT) Program on Pregnancy and Kidney Disease aims to empower the next generation of leaders in obstetric nephrology. Participants ("Trainers") will gain the tools and support to expand clinical expertise, build educational capacity, and drive change globally.

#### Program objectives:

- 1. Build capacity in obstetric nephrology through a "ripple effect" by training future trainers and leaders.
- 2. Promote and expand the ISN Academy Obstetric Nephrology educational resources.
- 3. Establish a global network to foster collaboration and innovation in the field.

## Apply to join the 2025–2026 Trainer Cohort

We invite expressions of interest (EOIs) from individuals committed to advancing care for pregnancy and kidney disease.

#### Eligibility criteria

- Demonstrated clinical leadership or experience in obstetric nephrology.
- Must be at a career stage where mentorship through this program would significantly advance leadership in the field.
- **English fluency** for scientific and educational communications.
- Additional language skills are an asset to support global reach.
- Applications from underrepresented **geographic regions** will be prioritized.
- Must be an ISN member or willing to join the ISN















- Full commitment to the program and post-program activities (September 2025–2026), including:
  - o Regular virtual meetings (every few months)
  - o Educational content development
  - o Collaboration with faculty and fellow trainers

## **Application requirements**

- Full name, contact information, institution, and qualifications
- CV with a 1-page summary of clinical and/or academic contributions to obstetric nephrology
- A statement (max 300 words) outlining:
  - Why you want to join the program
  - o Your goals for obstetric nephrology locally
- Names and email addresses of two referees

## Selection process

The cohort will be carefully selected to fulfil the aims of the program. Due to limited space, not all applicants will be accepted. The selection decisions are final.
